Regular Meeting of Board of Directors Minutes

Saturday, March 24, 2012, Fremont, California

1. Call to Order

The regular trimesterly meeting of the Board of Directors of SFSFC, Inc., was held on Saturday, March 24, 2012, in the Depot Cafe, 37260 Fremont Blvd., Fremont CA 94536. The meeting was called to order at 11:02, President David Gallaher presiding and Secretary Kevin Standlee recording. Members present (*by telephone †*ex officio* non-voting director ‡director emeritus): Sandra Childress, David W. Clark (arrived 11:07), Nancy L. Cobb, Wolfgang Coe, David Gallaher, Glenn Glazer, Lisa Deutsch Harrigan, Cheryl Morgan*, Kevin Roche† (Westercon 66), Cindy Scott, Kevin Standlee, Andy Trembley† (Westercon 66). Members absent: Chris Garcia† (Corflu 28), Spike, Tom Whitmore‡.

2. Previous Minutes

The minutes of the previous meetings are now adopted by unanimous consent via the Board e-mail list and published on the corporation's web site.

3. Officer Reports

3.1. President

The President had no report at this time.

3.2. Treasurer

Treasurer Lisa Deutsch Harrigan reported. She now has custody of the corporate financial records, but only recently.

Assistant Treasurer Cindy Scott reported on ongoing issues with an ongoing dispute with the IRS over old informational filings.

Mr. Coe asked who has signature authority on their accounts: Treasurer Harrigan, Assistant Treasurers Scott and Standlee, and President Gallaher.

3.2.1. Financial Statements

The Treasurer distributed paper copies of reports (See Appendices A-B) and discussed them in detail. The general-fund statements do not include all standing committees and need some more cleaning up.

3.2.2. Informational Filings

We have filed our Form 990 for FY2010-11. The current fiscal year ends at the end of this month, and our Form 990 for FY2011-12 will be due 4 ½ months after that.

3.3 Secretary

Web site: Everything up to date. Assistant Treasurer Scott will send a copy of the Form 990 to Secretary Standlee for posting on the web site, consistent with our usual practice.

4. Standing Committee Reports

4.1. Westercon 2011 Organizing Committee

Mr. Glazer reported. The Westercon books are closed (See Appendices C-D for financial statements) and the committee is ready to close.

At 11:14 AM, the meeting went into Committee of the Whole, Nancy L. Cobb presiding.

At 11:26, the Committee of the Whole rose and reported that

- Because of attrition payments, Westercon 64 has a net loss of \$1,255.70. The loss was covered by the SFSFC general fund. (The Westercon 64 balance sheet in Appendix D shows a positive balance because of money loaned from the General Fund to Westercon 64 which will be settled with the closure of the WC64 accounts and transfer of remaining money to the General Fund.)
- Westercon 64 has some leftover supplies that it will donate to Westercon 66.
- There are no objections to discharging the Westercon 64 Committee.

The Westercon 2011 Committee moved the following resolution:

Motion 2012-02:1 Westercon 2011

Moved, to discharge the Westercon 2011 Organizing Committee established by Resolution 2008-04.

Motion 2012-02 was adopted by unanimous consent, and the Westercon 64 committee was discharged.

4.2. Corflu 2011 Organizing Committee

Corflu Treasurer Lisa Detusch Harrigan reported. Corflu 2011 ended with a surplus (Appendices E-F). Corflu 2011 has passed along \$500 to the 2012 Corflu and will pass along any remaining surplus to the 2013 Corflu, consistent with the traditional practice of this convention. The Corflu 2011 Committee expects to recommend that it be discharged at the next Board meeting.

4.3. London 2014 Bid Committee

Spike reported by e-mail. (Appendix G) This committee continues to be managed as a flow-through account on behalf of the UK 2014 committee, handling only USD cash and checks. Credit card charges go directly to the UK 2014 committee.

4.4. Westercon 66 Committee

Co-Chairs Andy Trembley and Kevin Roche reported. At 11:39 AM, the meeting went into Committee of the Whole, Nancy L. Cobb presiding, to discuss Westercon 66.

¹ Resolutions and formal motions are recorded in continuous sequence within a calendar year. The Secretary issues numbers to motions and resolutions, but such numbered motions and resolutions may not appear in consecutive order in the minutes due to matters submitted in advance being assigned earlier numbers.

At 12:09 PM, the Committee of the Whole rose and reported that Westercon 66 currently has 182 members (including 63 supporting members, 62 of whom are unconverted site-selection voters). (See also Appendices H-I for financial statements.) The Westercon 66 committee has selected a preferred hotel in the Arden Fair area of Sacramento and is working to finalize a contract. The committee will announce the date and venue as soon as they can conclude an agreement with the venue. The committee is negotiating with guests, but some of them can't be finalized until we settle the date and venue. Westercon 66 will have a presence at CostumeCon, BayCon, Westercon 65, and other conventions in the medium-term future.

4.5. Nebula Awards Weekend

David Gallaher reported. At 12:10 PM, the meeting went into Committee of the Whole, Nancy L. Cobb presiding, to discuss The Nebula Awards Weekend.

At 12:15 PM, the Committee of the Whole rose and reported that the Nebula Awards Weekend committee has been working with SFWA regarding arrangements for SFSFC to host the 2013 and 2014 Nebula Awards Weekends, and has been soliciting proposals from downtown San Jose hotels for this purpose.

The meeting recessed at 12:16 PM and reconvened at 12:31 PM.

5. Special Committee Reports

5.1. SMOFCon Scholarship Committee

We are not currently planning on presenting a scholarship this year, although we would like to leave open the prospect of doing so in the future.

The SMOFCon Scholarship Committee was continued by unanimous consent.

5.2. Strategic Development Committee

At 12:33 PM, the meeting went into Committee of the Whole, Nancy L. Cobb presiding, meeting as the Strategic Development Committee.

At 1:47 PM, the Committee of the Whole rose and

- Reported that President Gallaher has been attending meetings of the San Jose CVB's client advisory board, and that he advised us of plans for the expansion/remodel of the San Jose Convention Center:
- That the SDC discussed the future strategic direction for SFSFC in detail, but has no specific recommendations for the formation of committees or commitments to events at this time;
- That the SDC received a presentation from Ms. Childress regarding her investigation of the SalesForce product:
- Recommended that the SDC be continued.

The Strategic Development Committee was continued by unanimous consent.

5.3 Code of Conduct Policy Committee

Ms. Morgan reported that they have made no progress on this, and asks that it be continued until the next meeting. The Code of Conduct Policy Committee was continued by unanimous consent.

6. Unfinished Business

There were no items of unfinished business postponed from the previous meeting.

7. New Business

7.1 Bylaw Amendment: Bay Area Definition

Mr. Glazer moved the adoption of the following amendment to the Bylaws:

Resolution 2012-01: Bay Area Definition

Resolved, To amend the SFSFC bylaws for the purpose of adding Santa Cruz County to the corporation's definition of the San Francisco Bay Area, by <u>adding</u> words in Section 15.4 as shown:

15.4 San Francisco Bay Area.

The San Francisco Bay Area, for purposes of these Bylaws, shall be defined as the Counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, and the City and County of San Francisco.

Mr. Glazer explained that this motion was intended to at least retroactively recognize the fact that we've been holding some meetings at his home in Felton, which is in Santa Cruz County.

Mr. Standlee pointed out that, per section 4.3 of the Bylaws, *regular* meetings of the corporation can be held anywhere (even outside of California); it is only *special* meetings that must be held within the SF Bay Area as defined in the Bylaws; therefore, none of our meetings in Felton (all of which were regular meetings) were illegal. Mr. Standlee then moved to amend the amendment by inserting "Sacramento" in the appropriate place. This amendment was approved by unanimous consent, so that the proposal now read to change Section 15.4 as follows:

15.4 San Francisco Bay Area.

The San Francisco Bay Area, for purposes of these Bylaws, shall be defined as the Counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, <u>Sacramento</u>, San Mateo, Santa Clara, <u>Santa Cruz</u>, Solano, Sonoma, and the City and County of San Francisco.

After further discussion, Resolution 2012-01 (as amended) was adopted by unanimous consent.

8. Announcements/Future Meetings

8.1. 2012 Meetings

The previously-announced July meeting date has become increasingly inconvenient for some of our members, including both the President and Secretary. After discussion, future meeting dates for 2012 were re-scheduled as follows:

 - o The Board expects to hold an informal retreat on July 22, 2012 in Felton.
- November 17, 2012, Centerville, 11 AM Pacific Time

The President will make the reservations with the Depot Café for these dates.
