ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MARCH FONG LU, Secretary of SAN FRANCISCO SCIENCE FICTION CONVENTIONS, INCORPORTED

A California Public Benefit Corporation

Article I

The name of this corporation is San Francisco Science Fiction Conventions, Incorporated.

Article II

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are the promotion and development of science fiction and fantasy in all its forms, including, but not limited to, literature, film, drama, and art.

Article III

The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is Daniel Murphy, 1283 38th Avenue, San Francisco, California, 94122.

Article IV

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, and literary purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article V

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist in carrying on propaganda, nor otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate

or intervene in any political campaign, including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.


Article VII

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On the basis of information submitted and provided your present operations continue unchanged or conform to those proposed in your application, you are exempt from state franchise or income tax under Section 23701d, Revenue and Taxation Code. Any change in operation, character or purpose of the organization must be reported immediately to this office so that we may determine the effect on your exempt status. Any change of name or address also must be reported.

You are required to file Form 199 (Exempt Organization Annual Information Return) or Form 199B (Exempt Organization Annual Information Statement) on or before the 15th day of the 5th month (4½ months) after the close of your accounting period. See annual instructions with forms for requirements.

You are not required to file state franchise or income tax returns unless you have income subject to the unrelated business income tax under Section 23731 of the Code. In this event, you are required to file Form 109 (Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return) by the 15th day of the 5th month (4½ months) after the close of your annual accounting period.

If the organization is incorporating, this approval will expire unless incorporation is completed with the Secretary of State within 60 days.

Exemption from federal income or other taxes and other state taxes requires separate applications.
